Since joining the Women's Resource Center in 2006, Amber has been instrumental in strengthening the organization's financial sustainability and public presence. As Director of Development and Communications, she leads fundraising, donor relations, and marketing efforts, overseeing major events like the Champions for Change Gala, corporate partnerships, and grant acquisition. She also manages the agency's communications strategy, including branding, social media, media outreach, and donor engagement materials, ensuring alignment with fundraising goals and mission impact.

Beyond her work at WRC, Amber has served on the Board of Directors for Georgia Shares, a federation of nonprofits dedicated to expanding opportunities and resources for all Georgians, and on the Field Education Advisory Board for Georgia State University's School of Social Work.
